The following items in the 2016 Sportsman Modified rulebooks, both Asphalt and Dirt, have been clarified and/or updated (2 pages). Please contact Mike Bruno at (802) 236-9141 with questions.

2. ENGINE - DIRT (Clarification)

4. The only engine approved for use in the Modified division in 2016 is the General Motors "602" crate engine (Part # 88958602 or # 19258602) with approved seals.
a. NOTE: RPM, DMO, and Hunt's seals are suggested for Dirt events but not required.

2. ENGINE - DIRT (Clarification)

5. "358" engines are not approved without prior consent. These engines will use a trackmandated carburetor restrictor plate and are subject to other restrictions including weight and gearing. Any "358" engines will be considered ONLY for one-time trial-basis use in Dirt Track events and will not be permitted for regular weekly competition.

4. EXHAUST – ASPHALT (Clarification)

Only Schoenfeld headers Part # 1122B or # 1122BCM will be permitted. Exhaust headers must not exceed 1-5/8" in outside diameter. Tri-Y, step headers, stainless steel, coated, ceramic and/or otherwise, and/or merge collectors will not be permitted. Beyea header Part # NEDM602 not allowed in Asphalt Track events.

4. EXHAUST - DIRT (Clarification)

Only Schoenfeld headers Part # 1122B or # 1122BCM will be permitted. Exhaust headers must not exceed 1-5/8" in outside diameter. Tri-Y, step headers, stainless steel, coated, ceramic and/or otherwise, and/or merge collectors will not be permitted. Beyea header Part # NEDM602 allowed in Dirt Track events but may be subject to weight penalty.

4. EXHAUST - ASPHALT & DIRT (Clarification)

6. Exhaust pipe ends may be angled straight down to ground or may exit above rear tires. Pipes may dump out of doors, but must be flush with body panels.

9. REAR END - ASPHALT & DIRT (Clarification)

4. No live axle rears allowed. No "high dollar" lightweight rears. No V8 midget-style rears allowed. No lockers.

13. CHASSIS - DIRT (Delete rule)

4.—No raised frame rails.

13. CHASSIS - ASPHALT & DIRT (Clarification)

9. Engine must be centered in the front of the chassis. Location must be a minimum 58" from centerline of front axle to rear engine plate. Crankshaft height from bottom of frame to centerline of crank must be a minimum of 8", NO TOLERANCE. Engine tilt back no more than 5 degrees.

13. CHASSIS - ASPHALT (Delete rule)

14. Chassis not equipped with fully-functioning, dirt-style rear torsion racks must add 40 lbs. of ballast behind the rear axle.

13. CHASSIS - ASPHALT (Add rule)

15. No new chassis may have rear torsion racks removed. Existing chassis without rear torsion racks may be subject to weight penalty.

13. CHASSIS - DIRT (Delete rule)

14. No new chassis may have rear torsion racks removed. Existing chassis without rear torsion racks may be subject to weight penalty in the future.

15. FUEL/FUEL CELL – ASPHALT & DIRT (Clarification)

2. Fuel cell mandatory, maximum 24 gallons. Fuel cell must be mounted behind driver, centered in rear of car.
