

PORTLAND GLASS MINI STOCK SWEEPSTAKES



The open-competition season finale on Sunday, September 17 will pay up to \$1,000 to the Mini Stock winner. Nine guaranteed starting positions were available through qualifying races on August 6, August 13, and August 27. Portland Glass has posted a purse of \$750 to win on September 17, and <u>drivers who attempted to race in all three qualifying events will be eligible to win an extra \$250 for a total of \$1,000.</u> In each qualifying race, the two top-finishing "Home Track" drivers who were ranked inside the Top 20 in Devil's Bowl Dirt Track championship points at that time earned a starting spot in the finale, as well as the top-finishing "At Large" driver who was either ranked outside the Top 20 in points or competes regularly at another speedway.
